JEWISH COMMUNITY OVERWHELMINGLY SUPPORTS FEDERATION HEADQUARTERS REMAINING IN DOWNTOWN CLEVELAND

General community agrees

CLEVELAND, OH -- Today, The Committee to Keep JCF in CLE announced the results of a poll of Cleveland area residents to evaluate opinions on the proposed move of the Jewish Community Federation's headquarters from downtown Cleveland to Beachwood. The survey was conducted on September 9, 2008 using a random sample of adults living in areas of the Jewish community and sought the opinions of both the general population and specifically members of Jewish community.

The findings concluded that:

Communitywide (Sample size: 1,398, 2.7% margin of error)

JCF should remain in downtown Cleveland	37.2%
JCF Should move from downtown to Beachwood	20.9%
Undecided/Unsure	41.9%

Jewish Community -- Subset (Sample size: 363, 5.2% margin of error)

JCF should remain in downtown Cleveland	44.1%
JCF Should move from downtown to Beachwood	25.3%
Undecided/Unsure	30.6%
